

## Medical Forms Required

### Physical and Immunization Forms - Kindergarten, Grade 6 and Grade 9

All new students and Kindergarten students and students entering grades six and nine are required by the state of Illinois to have an updated physical form AND Immunization form on file at the school. This form should show that all immunizations are up to date and that your child is able to participate in school. This is a standard state form that you can get from the doctor's office by calling them and letting them know your child will attend school in the fall. Returning students entering Kindergarten or students that have had new immunizations since last year's physical form should bring an updated copy.

ALL primary and toddler students also need an updated physical/immunization report on file each year.

### Vision Screening (for students age 5 and over)

Public Act 95-671, effective **January 1, 2008**, requires that all children enrolling in kindergarten in a public, private or parochial school and any student enrolling for the first time in a public, private or parochial school shall have an eye examination.

- Each such child is to present proof of having been examined by a physician licensed to practice medicine in all its branches or a licensed optometrist within the previous year before **October 15** of the school year.

### Dental Form - Kindergarten, Grade 2 and Grade 6

All Illinois children in kindergarten and Grades 2 and 6 are required to have an oral health examination.

- This requirement includes all public, private, and parochial schools.
- Examinations must be performed by a licensed dentist, and he/she must sign the proof of school dental examination form.
- Each child is required to present proof of examination by a dentist prior to May 15 of the school year.
- School dental examinations must have been completed within the 18 months prior to the May 15 deadline.
