



2023-2024 Supply List

Toddler (15 Months - 35 Months)

- 1 pair of simple indoor shoes to leave at school (Light weight, easy on and off - **NO** croc style shoes please)
- 3 complete outfits (shirt, pants, socks, and underclothing) label all items with the child's name
- 1 small backpack
- 5 wallet sized pictures of your child
- 1 family photo (5x7)
- 1 wet clothes bag medium size
- 1 11x14 poster board (for a family project to be completed at home)
- 1 (1/2 inch) binder with the clear view window on it (Please write your child's name on the paper inside the cover - not on the plastic)

Primary 3-6 Year Old

1 pair of slippers or indoor shoes - no big head or furry characters please – soles should be non-skid (no croc style shoes) – and slippers should go around the ankle (no open heels)

Full Day Students need a lunch box and thermos for hot meals (soup, macaroni and cheese, etc.) We suggest a lunch box with small containers inside

One pair of rubber pull-on boots to be left at school

During the first week of school your family will be assigned a few other items to bring in as a community classroom supply

Elementary Grades 1- 6

***Unless clearly noted, please: **DO NOT label items with your child's name.**
Most supplies will be used by the class community.

Everyone - 1st - 6th Year Students

- 1 box of 100 page protectors labeled with your child's name on the box
- 1 pair of well fitting indoor shoes with hard soles to be left in the classroom
- 1 box of #2 Ticonderoga Pencil Set - 18-24 pencils total **DO NOT label with your child's name.**
Please purchase this brand as the pencil leads do not break easily and the pencils sharpen nicely.
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 hand pencil sharpener
- Medium weight pad of sketching paper
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 package of WIDE RULED loose leaf notebook paper
- \$3 for botany supplies

In addition to the list above, the following is needed for the specified grade level for each of your children:

1st - 3rd Year Students

- 1 black and white composition book/wide ruled (1st years ONLY)
- 1 package of sidewalk chalk
- 1 gallon white vinegar
- 1 package of ultra-thin sharpies
- 1 box non- iodized table salt (this is not for eating, the cheaper the better)
- one (1 1/2 inch) 3-ring binder (view binder) with a cover insert- **DO NOT write directly on the plastic binder** - write your child's name on the paper inside the front cover of the binder

4th-6th Year Students

- One (1 1/2 inch) binder with 5 or more dividers (can bring back the one from last year, if applicable)
- 1 composition notebook - (any cover)
- 2 two-pocket folders
- 1 ream plain white paper
- 1 package of loose-leaf WIDE ruled notebook paper
- one (2 inch) 3 ring view binder with a cover insert. **DO NOT write directly on the plastic binder** - write your child's name on the paper inside the front cover of the binder

Adolescent Students

- Student Planner (Students should take time to look at different layouts and choose one that makes the most sense in their mind)
- Pencil case containing personal writing supplies (pens, pencils, erasers, pencil sharpener, 2 highlighters of different colors)
- 1 sketchbook or art paper pad
- 5 subject spiral notebook
- 1 one subject spiral notebooks
- 1 package of looseleaf notebook paper
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Rain boots (or use school left overs)
- Sanitary/ personal items to leave in backpack or bathroom (deodorant, feminine products in a personal zipper pouch with name marked please- students do not share stock)
- Indoor shoes - (if slippers they must be hard soles)
- 2 one-and-a-half-inch binders
- 2 two inch binders
- 2 two-pocket folders
- 100 page protectors
- 1 package of white notecards - lined
- 1 package of color notecards - lined
